Utah Symphony | Utah Opera and the Utah Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association collaborated for a *ninth year* in presenting a variety of events for members of our community who are Alzheimer's care recipients and their caregivers, both in USUO's venues (attendance at a Finishing Touches rehearsal) and in regional care centers. People with Alzheimer's have memories that suffer, but their other senses may be totally intact, and listening to music can give them as much or more joy than it does USUO's usual audience members. It meant a

lot to care center staff and families of people who have Alzheimer's that our professional musicians were providing services to their loved ones; they felt a broader community support and recognition for their life challenges. Some staff mentioned enjoying seeing their charges alert and focused during the concerts.

During our <u>Finishing Touches rehearsal on May 17</u>, we provided a table where Alzheimer's Association representatives could provide information and brochures about their programs. We distributed <u>45 complimentary tickets</u> to the rehearsal.

Artists from Utah Symphony | Utah Opera visited care centers to take live professional music to Alzheimer's care recipients who are unable to travel to enjoy musical experiences. Eleven performances were offered in area care centers. In total, our professional musicians performed for approximately 270 people in these special concerts this year. Many of the presentations were in



Memory Care Units. We also performed in several Adult Day Care centers, where many Alzheimer's care recipients spend their days while their families are still able to accommodate them at home in the evenings and overnight.
