Question 1. When and where was the art form of opera invented?

Answer: around 400 years ago, in Italy

Question 2. What are the four opera voice types described and demonstrated in this episode of *Who Wants to be an Opera Star*?

Answer: Soprano, Mezzo (or mezzo-soprano), Tenor, Bass

Question 3. What is the other word we use for the "tune" in a piece of music?

Answer: the Melody

Question 4. What is the musical term we use for how long or how short the notes are?

Answer: the Rhythm

Question 5. What is the word for objects the singers use to help tell the story?

Answer: Props (or Properties)

Question 6. How many people sing in an opera *aria*?

Answer: One (it's a solo)

Question 7. What is the Italian word we use at the end of a musical number, while we're applauding, to tell opera singers they did a great job?

Answer: Bravo!
